Courses:

Each course will equip participants with the knowledge, skills and confidence to care for children with various needs including:

- care and management of children with epilepsy
- care and management of children with type one diabetes
- paediatric asthma management and anaphyaxis in children
- tracheostomy care and management in children
- ostomy, stoma and gastrostomy care in children
- developmental delay and spectrum disorders in children.

The suite of six courses runs over three months with two courses per month. Participants can attend one course (half day) or two courses (full day) each month.
