### 1. Introduction

#### 1.1 Purpose

Students are required to contribute to the cost of their own training through the payment of a cocontribution fee.

#### 1.2 Scope and context

This procedure applies to all training programs delivered by Mater Education (MEL) under its Skills Assure Supplier approved Career Start or Career Boost VET Qualifications schedule.

This procedure also applies to full fee-paying students (that are ineligible to access subsidises or who choose not to utilise funding availability)

This procedure does not apply to VET in Schools approved VET Qualifications or School-Based Traineeships.

# 2. Procedure requirements

The following procedures are to be followed

### 2.1 Charging student co-contribution fee

MEL will charge a student co-contribution fee at the unit of competency level for all students accessing funding under the Career Start or Career Boost program and in the case of traineeships, where the student is not a school-based trainee.

The co-contribution fee charged, no matter the enrolment type, will represent the cost to students for training and assessment services and awarding the qualification.

Students may also be required to purchase additional materials including uniforms, clothing, footwear, electronic equipment or program essentials e.g. criminal history checks, vaccinations. These are specific to each course and are listed in the relevant program page on MEL's website.

#### 2.2 Collection of student co-contribution fees

MEL will not collect the full co-contribution fee upfront where students are funded under the Career Start or Career Boost programs. MEL will not request or demand more than 30% of the total co-contribution fee upfront. This does not apply to full fee-paying students where fees will be collected up to the \$1500 threshold amount in any one transaction and only as training and assessment services are provided i.e. not multiple invoices under the threshold at the same time. are not school based trainees, fees will be collected at \$1.60 per nominal hour and calculated at the commencement of each unit of competency.

When the student converts from a school-based trainee to a full-time or part-time traineeship, student co-contribution fees must be charged for training and assessment for any units of competency not yet commenced.

### 2.3 Following up on unpaid co-contribution fees

MEL will follow the Non-Payment of Tuition Fees Procedure to collect outstanding tuition fees.
