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Units of competency covered by fees

D. The Skills Assure Supplier (SAS) must charge, collect and report co-contribution fees at the Unit of Competency level. Co-contribution fees must be reported in whole dollar values for each unit via the SAS's VET activity data submission, regardless of who pays the Co-contribution fee. Unit fees must total the published Co-contribution fee and be calculated either by evenly dividing the total Co-contribution fee across payable units or proportionally based on the relative length of each unit. The SAS must retain evidence of all Co-contribution fees charged and collected.
