

Mater Education Students Placement ABC's

Please see below for the Placement ABC's while on Placement.

A. Student Facilitator

While on Placement, you will be allocated a Student Facilitator (SF). Your SF is your first point of call for all placement queries.

The role of the SF is to "assist in education, assessment and support of the student while on Placement".

Your SF will source and utilise opportunities within the placement facility for students to practice and demonstrate competencies within their scope of practice.

Your SF will contact you prior to commencing placement and will inform you of the best way to contact them i.e... SMS or TEAMS.

B. Absenteeism

It is your responsibility to attend all allocated shifts.

If you are unable to attend your allocated shift you must inform your SF as well as the Ward prior to commencement of the shift. This includes all night duty and weekends shifts.

If you need to leave early due to illness/family/emergency, you must inform your SF as well as the Ward prior to leaving your shift.

C. Missed Shifts

Mater Hospitals have nursing students from the many Universities in our district attending their Facilities: not just from Mater Education. This means that available shifts are highly sought after.

Missed shifts will be allocated by the Student Placements Team dependant on ward availability: these make-up shifts will be arranged after your scheduled Placement Block has ended and therefore may be arranged at a time other than shown on your timetable.

You will be notified via your SF once these shifts are confirmed on SPOT.

Progression to your next semester of study is dependent on a successful placement outcome and therefore all shifts must be completed.
